
OBJECTIVE OF TOPIC J

Focus Area-Topic J

Development of Subtraction Fluency Within 10

Students will write related number sentences for a number bond.




$$9 - 6 = 3$$

$$6 + 3 = 9$$

$$9 - 3 = 6$$

$$3 + 6 = 9$$

When the parts are the same, there are only two related facts.



$$10 - 5 = 5$$

$$5 + 5 = 10$$
